Cookies with Santa: Cookies with Santa will be on Thursday, December 21th from 4-5:30. Come meet Santa and enjoy a sweet treat with your child.

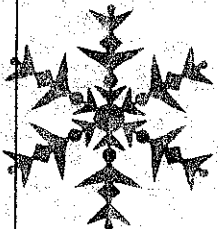

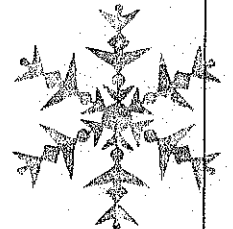

Please make sure that your child has their head and hands covered with a hat/hood and gloves/mittens. And, although it will be cold outside, it can get pretty warm in the classroom as well, so it is a good idea to dress in removable layers.
