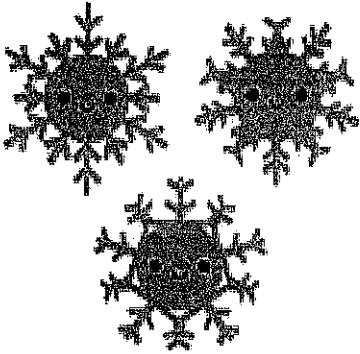


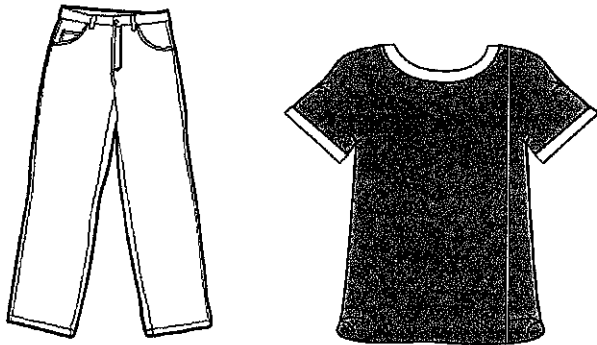
# Classroom 114 Newsletter

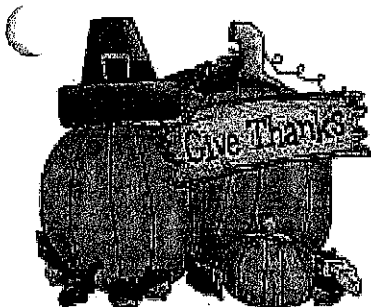

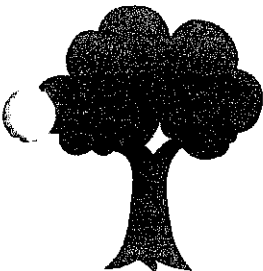
