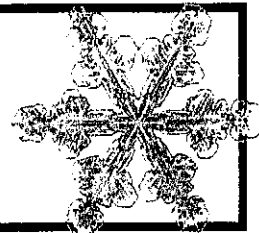

Stress and Your Baby

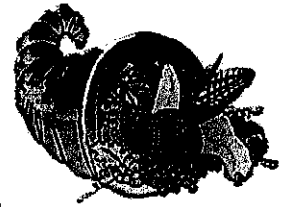
Just like you, your baby can get stressed. Babies get stressed when their needs aren't met. You can help your baby when she gets upset. By calming your baby down (by holding her, rocking her, singing, etc.) she learns how to calm herself and that's important.

Respond as quickly as you can to your baby's needs. Try different ways to calm her. Don't leave your baby to "cry it out" when she's upset. Letting a baby deal with stress on her own will NOT make her a tougher adult. Babies NEED adults to help them learn healthy ways to calm down.

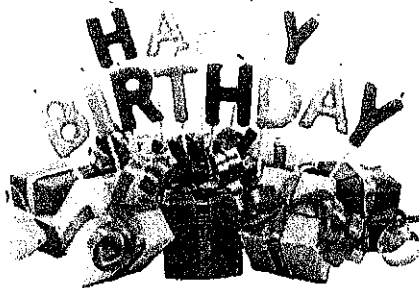

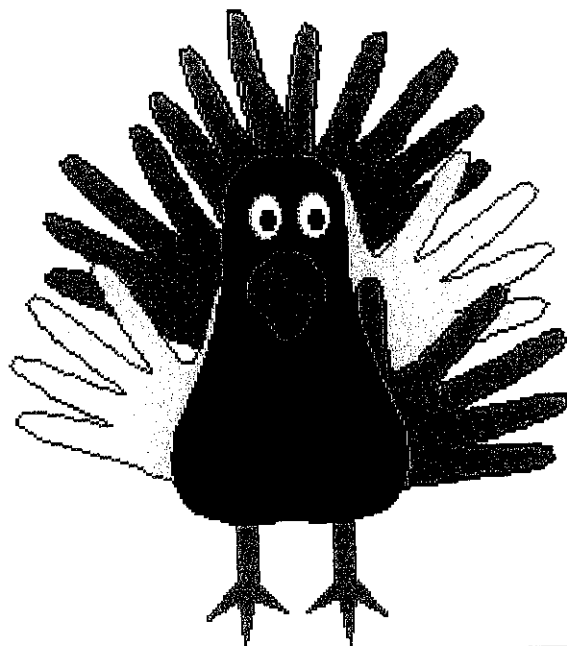
(Libby and Kim's) Newsletter

Education News:

The curriculum used in our Early Head Start program is called "High Scope." There are some key ideas used in this curriculum. One of the main ideas is for the infants or toddlers to be given many **choices** throughout the day. Another idea is to have lots of **materials** available to be used..The infants or toddlers are given many toys and items in order to **manipulate, or explore** the many things around them by using all of their senses **Communication and language development** are also very important keys used in helping your baby develop. Lots of talking and singing to the babies happens throughout the course of the day.
