Try This Over Break:

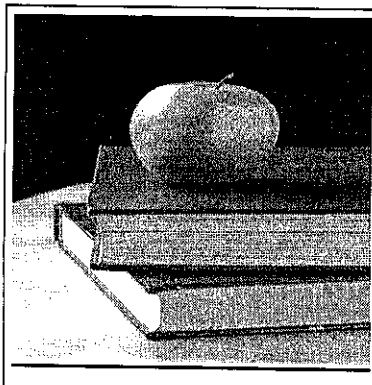
Peanut Butter Candy Cookies

- $\frac{1}{2}$ Cup peanut butter
- $\frac{1}{2}$ Cup sugar
- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup evaporated milk
- 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of cornflakes

Mix peanut butter, sugar and milk. Stir in cornflakes until thoroughly blended. Drop by teaspoonful onto un-greased cookie sheet. Bake for six minutes or until evenly browned.

- Please dress your child for the weather because we go outside with the weather permitting.

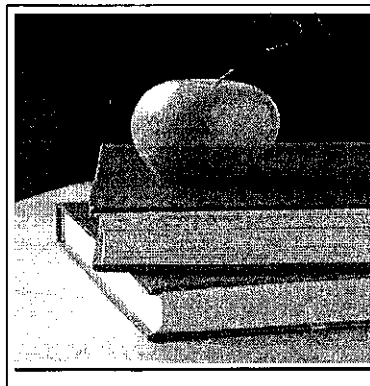
Finger-plays and Songs For the Month
