Parent Engagement

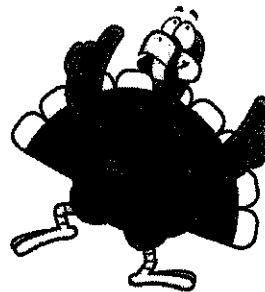
There will be class break for First Friday in November. The children **WILL** attend school on Friday November 6th, 2020.
