

# Do I qualify for Medicaid benefits?

## Pregnant women

Pregnant women will typically be covered through **Hoosier Healthwise (HHW)**.

Eligibility depends on:

- Pregnancy
- Income
- Family size



If needed, a pregnant woman can get instant help by applying for Presumptive Eligibility for Pregnant Women while she waits for the Medicaid application to finish. Visit [in.gov/medicaid/members/54.htm](http://in.gov/medicaid/members/54.htm) for more information.

### Details

- Count an unborn child as one in family size.
- Family size is based on the tax household, including unborn children. If you don't file taxes, the household includes the pregnant woman, her children (including unborn) and her spouse, if married.

## Children

Children who aren't disabled or living in an institution will be covered through **Hoosier Healthwise (HHW)** as well.



Eligibility depends on:

- Age (HHW covers children up to age 18)
- Income
- Family size

Having private insurance may affect eligibility.

If your child is disabled or living in an institution, please review the Aged, Blind and/or Disabled section.

Parents may have a monthly premium based on their income. Learn more about premiums at [in.gov/medicaid](http://in.gov/medicaid).

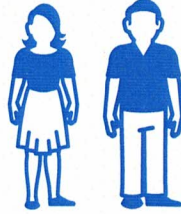

### Details

Family is based on the tax household. If you don't file taxes, the household includes the children, the children's parents (biological, adopted and step), and the children's siblings (biological, adopted and step).

## Adults

Most qualifying adults will be served through **Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP)**.



Eligibility depends on:

- Age (HIP covers adults ages 19 to 64)
- Income
- Family size

Having private insurance may affect eligibility.

If eligible for HIP, there are two options, HIP Basic and HIP Plus. HIP Basic members have copays and HIP Plus members are required to make a monthly contribution based on family income. To learn more about HIP Basic and HIP Plus, visit [chooseanthem.com/in](http://chooseanthem.com/in).

Details
Family size is based on the tax household. If you don't file taxes, the household includes the child, the child's parents (biological, adopted and step), and the child's siblings (biological, adopted and step).

## Aged, Blind and/or Disabled

Individuals who are aged, blind and/or disabled, including those institutionalized, will be covered through the **Hoosier Care Connect (HCC)** program.



Eligibility depends on:

- Income
- Family size

If disabled, the disability must meet the definition from the Social Security Administration.

Working disabled persons with slightly higher income may be eligible for M.E.D. Works and will be required to pay a monthly premium. Institutionalized, disabled persons with slightly higher incomes may be eligible and required to pay a monthly patient liability.

Family size	Income limit (per month)
1	\$1,064

Details
The income standard is based on the individual and their spouse, if married. Income of other household members are not counted.
